Re: Turf Weed Management

Turf weed populations have increased over the past couple months due to seasonal germination of warm season species. Treatments are currently in progress and will continue over the next 2 weeks throughout Kings Point. It typically takes 2 to 3 weeks for the systemic products being used to take full effect therefore we expect to see a significant decrease in overall weed populations in the next 4 to 6 weeks.

The high product rates necessary to achieve acceptable control of the hard-to-control weed species present at this time are likely to cause discoloration or stunting if temperature exceed 90 degrees. This does not mean the grass is dead. These treatment effects will be temporary if they occur, however it may take several weeks for turf to fully recover.

There has been very little rainfall since October and there are many dry areas throughout property. Weeds cannot be treated in drought stressed areas of the lawn due to high risk of causing significant and possibly irreversible damage to turf. Once rainy season begins and turf recovers we will treat weeds in these areas as needed.

We appreciate your patience as we execute this aggressive plan to get turf weed populations under control at Kings Point.
