Kings Point is NOW <u>required</u> to get our own water permit

# SCCW Master Association



Applied for Water Permit February 8, 2017.

- Applied for Water Permit Water usage is allocated based on the amount of arable acreage within the permit area.
- Permit allows for "banking" allowable water credits when there is rain, to be used later.

# Most Impacted Area (MIA)

Why is this drastic reduction happening?

### SCCW Master Association

Rate of saltwater intrusion into the Upper Florida aquifer along the coast, especially in the MOST IMPACTED AREA (MIA), area of about 708 square miles located along the coast of southern Hillsborough, Manatee and northwestern Sarasota counties.



# Water Use Caution Area (WUCA)

Why is this drastic reduction happening?

#### SCCW Master Association

A Water Use Caution Area, or WUCA, is an area where regional action is necessary to address cumulative water withdrawals which are causing or may cause adverse impacts to the water and related natural resources or the public interest. The District Governing Board designates WUCAs and establishes rules that enhance the protection and/or recovery of water resources.
